PH. II CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

As of 10/31/17

As we are nearing the official end of the Ph. II Capital Campaign to retire the debt from the Ph. I Building project, please see below status as of 10/31/17. We have made some very good progress in our debt reduction on this project thanks to all of the Sacred Heart Parishioners who have been so generous in their contributions toward this effort. In summary, we retired an additional **\$153,317.22** in loan principal since our last report on 12/31/16. Our balance on the long-term loan as of 10/31/17 is **\$146,092.60**. Again, thank you to all who have contributed to this Ph. II Debt Reduction campaign. Your efforts are greatly appreciated. For those who are still contributing towards their pledge amounts, please continue to do so. We will also continue to accept any additional contributions toward our overall campaign goal.

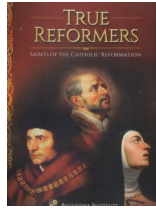

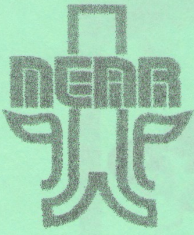
