From the Heart

<u>New Trustee Appointment</u>

Every Catholic Parish and indeed every Church in Minnesota can be incorporated in state law as a Religious Corporation. The MN Statute regarding Catholic Churches incorporated in this way establishes a Board of Directors consisting of five members including a President, Vice-President, Clergy Member, Secretary, and Treasurer. In Minnesota the President of Corporate Boards in Catholic Parishes is the (Arch)bishop, the Vice-President is the Pastor, the other Cleric is the Vicar-General of the (Arch)diocese, the Secretary and Treasurer of

the Corporation are drawn from the lay faithful, and are commonly known as Trustees. These five members make up the official corporate board of a Catholic Parish, including Sacred Heart. The President, Vice-President, and third cleric are *ex-officio* members of the board, while the lay members of the board are appointed by the Archbishop upon the recommendation of the Pastor. The lay Trustees are appointed for a term of two years, or until a successor trustee is appointed.

In the 107-year history of The Church of the Sacred Heart we have been blessed by dedicated lay trustees throughout our history. The reason for the appointment of a new trustee was the hiring of Mary Daugherty to serve as Parish Business Administrator last September. By law an employee of the parish may not serve as a trustee. Mary has served as the Secretary of our corporate board since the spring of 2007. I have been greatly blessed to have inherited both Art Zenzen, a trustee of many years who currently serves as Treasurer of our corporate board, and Mary Daugherty, who served as Secretary of our corporate board. In this case even though she no longer is a trustee, Sacred Heart still benefits from her business acumen, and leadership skills, and for that we can all be grateful.

I am also excited to announce the appointment of Theresa Gooley-Wolf to succeed Mary Daugherty on our corporate board. Theresa is the 7th lay person to serve on our corporate board as Secretary. Theresa has been a dedicated member of Sacred Heart since 1999. For many years she has served as a Lector at Sacred Heart, and has been serving on our Parish Finance Council for the past three years. Her husband is Lee Wolf, an attorney for the City Council of Minneapolis, with whom she has three children including Mary, currently at the University of Minnesota, Max, a senior at De LaSalle, and Anna, a Freshmen at De LaSalle. All of Theresa's children are graduates of Sacred Heart Catholic School. The Gooley-Wolf family have been active and supporting members of the mission of Sacred Heart through the years. Coming from a large Catholic family Theresa grew up as a member of St. Austin's Catholic Church. She is a graduate of the Carlson School of Management with a Bachelor of Science in Finance, and holds a law degree from Drake University. She is a practicing attorney in the State of Minnesota. She served as a law clerk for the Honorable Kathleen Blatz when the same served as Judge of the 4th Judicial District of Minnesota. Kathleen Blatz who would go on to serve as Associate Justice, and later as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Minnesota. Theresa currently serves as Managing Director of Management Liability, Bond & Specialty Insurance for Travelers. Her professional experience, education, and training will be an asset for The Church of the Sacred Heart and our mission in the years to come, and I am so grateful for her willingness to serve our Parish in this very important role. I likewise am grateful to his excellency, Archbishop Bernard Hebda for making this appointment. Please welcome, support, and pray for Theresa Gooley-Wolf as she begins her service to our Parish as our new Trustee.
