### Gratitude for You and for the Gift of the Priesthood

Last weekend June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018 we were blessed by the presence of Fr. Walter Sochacki, a son of Sacred Heart Parish, and his family members, as we acknowledged his 50 years of service in the priesthood. At 15 years of priesthood, my own time as a priest is but a fraction of Fr. Sochacki's time. Like Fr. Sochacki I am grateful for this gift. On his behalf and my own, thank you for your prayers and acknowledgment of these important milestones.

St. John Paul II, the Pope and Bishop of Rome in my youth and throughout my formative years in the seminary once said back on September 14, 1987 while visiting the USA in the City of Angels (Los Angeles) the following:

*"I am often asked, especially by young people, why I became a priest. Maybe some of you would like to ask the same question. Let me try briefly to reply. I must begin by saying that it is impossible to explain entirely. For it remains a mystery, even to myself. How does one explain the ways of God? Yet, I know that, at a certain point in my life, I became convinced that Christ was saying to me what he had said to thousands before me: 'Come, follow me!' There was a clear sense that what I heard in my heart was no human voice, nor was it just an idea of my own. Christ was calling me to serve him as a priest.*

*And you can probably tell that I am deeply grateful to God for my vocation to the priesthood. Nothing means more to me or gives me greater joy than to celebrate Mass each day and to serve God's people in the Church. That has been true ever since the day of my ordination as a priest. Nothing has ever changed this, not even becoming Pope."*

I can only echo the saintly Pope's words, and pray for an increase of holiness for myself and my brother priests in imitation of this "Great Pope."

### Archdiocesan Bankruptcy Settlement

No doubt you noted in the news a couple weeks ago that a \$210 million settlement agreement has been reached between the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis, past victims of sexual abuse who had sued the Archdiocese and many parishes including ours, and other creditors of the Archdiocese in its Bankruptcy proceedings. It is good news that a settlement has been reached that will provide some modicum of reparation to the victims of sexual abuse at the hands of a small group (though far too large) of Catholic clergy and religious. On my own behalf I can only echo how sorry I am that the "sins of the fathers" and other representatives of the Catholic Church robbed the innocence of so many, causing emotional pain, spiritual dislocation, and so many other consequences. Ultimately, God, through the love of the Heart of His Son, atones and can repair the damages done on account of sin. As St. Paul noted:

*"For we know that every creature groaneth and travaileth in pain, even till now. And not only it, but ourselves also, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption of the sons of God, the redemption of our body." - Romans 8:22-23*

May that healing continue and reach its fullness in the Resurrection. May God forgive us for our past failures, aid us in making reparation, and prevent us from future failures. This week I am including a statement from Archbishop Hebda on the settlement, and a Q & A from the Archdiocese about the same settlement.
