2018 CAPITAL EXPENSE FUND DRIVE 9/30/2018

Dear Parishioners,

We have several capital expense needs that have been on our radar for some time, but are not currently in our parish budget because it would create a large deficit. In consultation with the finance council and after discussion with staff, we believe it is in our best interest to move ahead with these major expense items as soon as we can. The estimated cost of all projects is \$50,000. **The good news is that six families have already pledged the first \$25,000 on the condition that the rest of the parish can match or exceed this amount with another \$25,000.** During the month of October, we plan on holding second collections for a 2018 Capital Expense Drive to accomplish this.

The capital projects and their estimated costs are as follows.

| 1. Stonework Repair for both the Church and School at the main doorways plus foundation work needed at the Convent building. | \$7,500 | Due to Minnesota winter and the necessary use of salt the pre-cast grey stone blocks that frame the doorways of the Church and School need repair. |
| 2. Upgraded microphone/sound system | \$15,000 | Our equipment is 20 years old and failing. New wireless microphones are also needed due to FCC bandwidth frequency changes. |
| 3. Flat Roof Replacement on a small area of the Church Building – Hubbard Ave. Vestibule | \$10,000 | This flat roof must be totally replaced as patching leaks is no longer effective. |
| 4. Enhanced elevator security for the safety of our students. | \$7,500 | This enhancement will "harden" our school against potential intruders while still allowing seamless use of the elevators for those in need. |
| 5. Marian Room Carpet Replacement | \$7,200 | The carpet is badly stained to the extent that deep cleaning is no longer effective. We will replace with high-quality carpet squares. |
| 6. Upgrade AED Units (defibrillators). | \$2,800 | While we hope they never need to be used, we need to have up-to-date defibrillators on campus due to a safety recall in case of emergency. |

We recognize that everyone's financial situation is different. But we are asking you to consider joining this effort according to how God has blessed you and your means. To meet our regular operations this gift must be over and above our usual giving. We will have a second collection for the next 3-4 weeks to raise the funds to pay for these items. If excess funds are raised, those funds will be used or saved up to tackle other "big ticket" projects on our Capital Improvement and Replacement plan, such as a new temperature control and energy management system for our heating and cooling systems in the Church, other flat roofs needing repair or replacement, or other capital needs on our list. ***Please consult the giving chart as you consider this appeal. Your gift could be more; it could be less. This is one example of how we could match the generous offer of our fellow parishioners.*** We thank you in advance for your participation and pray God will continue to bless you spiritually, financially and with good health. **THANK YOU!!!**

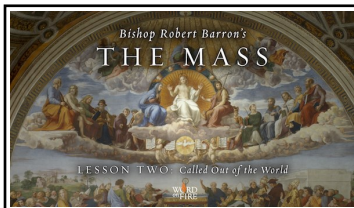

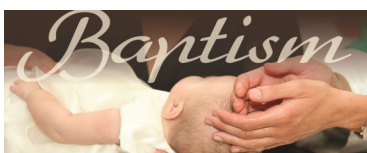
