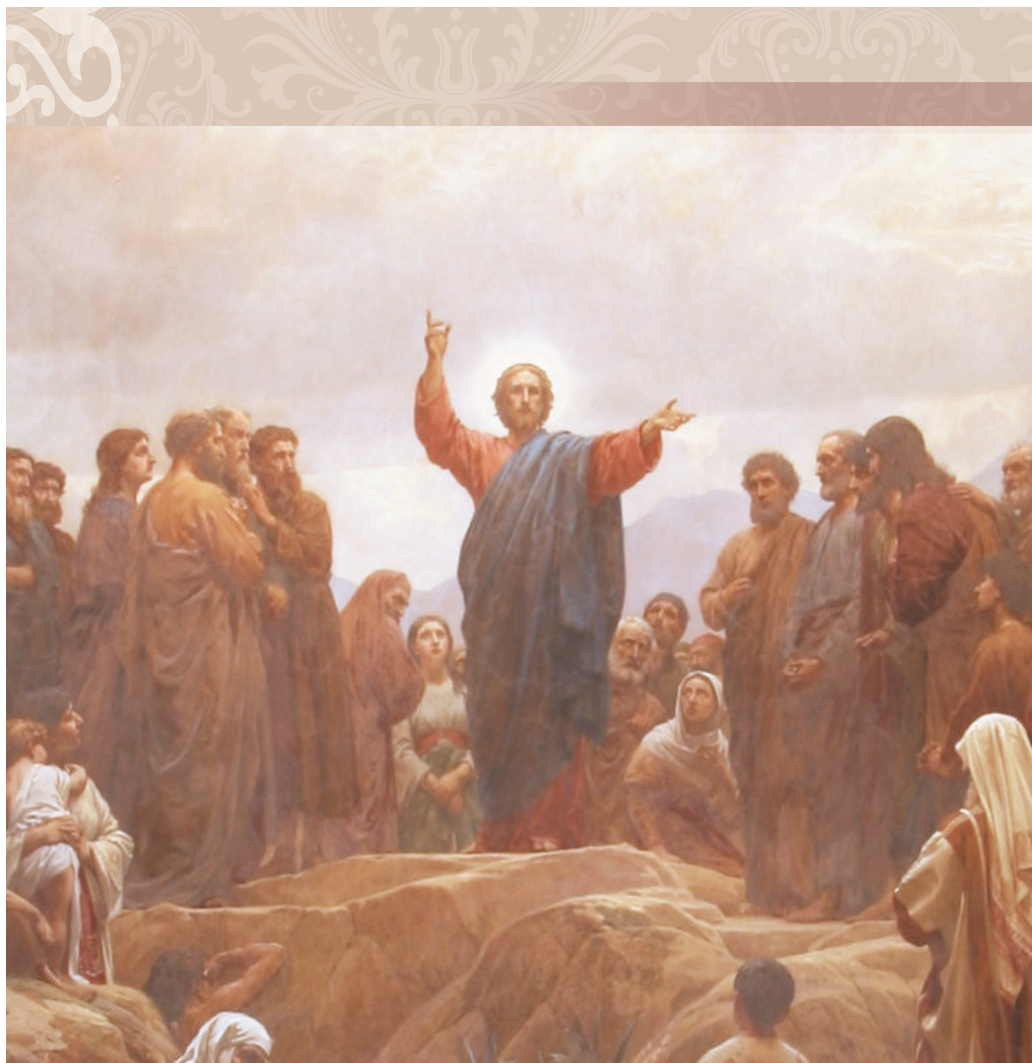

Work and Rest – Gifts of God Meant to be Life-Giving

This past Tuesday morning February 19th the Parish Staff and School Faculty had a spiritual/professional day for ongoing formation. One of our presenters Dr. Michael Naughton, Director of the Center for Catholic Studies at the University of St. Thomas offered us keen insights into our vocation as Catholic Educators. For us to fully embrace this vocation it requires a certain mindset, or vision concerning the nature of work and rest. Do we see our work as just a job, and our leisure or period of rest as the seeking of amusement and distraction so we can forget about our work? Or do we see our work as a vocation, and our leisure and rest time as meant for revitalizing our relationships? The vision we live by has profound impact on our happiness in life. This critical difference provides a Catholic vision of the weekends, and especially of Sunday, the "Dies Domini" or Day of the Lord, which God created for us. In this way our leisure and rest serve our relationship with God, with our family, and with our neighbors, and ultimately serves us. It is these relationships that give purpose to our work. When work is merely a job, and leisure /rest merely amusement and distraction, not only does our life become compartmentalized, but our work becomes life draining instead of life giving. Our leisure/rest becomes a kind of anesthetizing agent leading us to forget who we are, and who we are called to be. May the Lord help us to embrace this vision of leisure and rest, so our work can become a life-giving vocation.

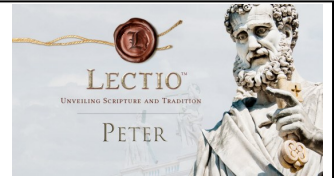

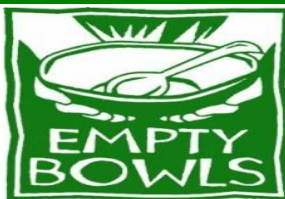
