

Restoration


Thanks to your support for our capital expense drive last fall yet another of our projects from the drive is now being realized, namely, restorations of the pre-cast stone door frames of our School Building, School Cornerstone, and Church doors. In addition, the repairs on the foundation of the 1927 Convent building is nearly complete. Our contractor, Solid Masonry and Restoration is the same contractor who repointed (aka tuckpointing) on the Church Building in 2016. The work on the door frames was not a part of that earlier contract. The company is small, currently including the owner, Patrick Sieben, and his two sons, who serve as apprentices. Like many of their generation they are skilled with technology, yet the world will always need stone masons and brick layers, and all of what I am dubbing "the manual arts" including carpentry, plumbing, electrical engineering, and the other various building trades. To have skills and training in some trade even for those who are college bound, I think, is an excellent idea. Among the many things I wish I had gained was some training in include a trade. St. Paul, the principal patron of our Archdiocese, in addition to being perhaps the greatest missionary preacher Christianity has ever known, was also a tent maker. This trade sustained his apostolic ministry, a point he made to the Corinthian Church as recorded by St. Luke in Acts 18:1-4.

AIM Higher Scholarships open up a new summer application period

AIM Higher has additional scholarship money to award students that want to attend a Catholic school. The process is open until August 4th.

Here are four things to know:

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded on a rolling basis to help new families make a quick decision about where to send their children.
- 2. For any family who applied after the first deadline (February 17) to be considered, they <u>will need to go back into TADS</u> and update their application. Instructions below.

Parents and guardians can add the Aim Higher Foundation to an existing TADS application from their TADS accounts.

Here's how:

- On the home screen, under the "Most Recent Financial Aid Application" section, click the green Add School button.
- Click the green Add School or Scholarship button (yes, again).
- In the School Search field, type Aim Higher (or even Aim will work).
- A dropdown menu will appear; click to select Aim Higher.
- Select which student or students you would like to apply for Aim Higher, then click the
- green Submit button.

Follow the step-by-step instructions to complete adding the scholarship.


