

Faith Formation Update

As we begin July in our new fiscal year I would like to update you on some changes in our staffing for our Faith Formation Programs. For well over two decades we have been ably served in Faith Formation by our DRE, or Director of Religious Education, Bunny Brouillard. The good news for us is that Bunny will continue to serve Sacred Heart Parish in a new position while at the same time taking a step back from other responsibilities, which in turn will allow her more time with her granddaughter Evie. Her new title is Director of Adult Faith Formation. As DRE, this was already part of her responsibilities, however, in the academic year ahead her focus will now be exclusively on planning, promoting, and Implementing opportunities for ongoing Adult Faith Formation.

This includes coordinating Adult Bible Studies and other such programming. She will also continue in her role of coordinating our RCIA and RCIC programs (RCIA, or Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults, and RCIC, or Rites of Christian Initiation of Children), assist adults and children entering the Catholic faith with both Catechesis and the Celebration of the

Sacraments of Initiation to include Baptism, Confirmation, and Holv Eucharist.

Joining our Church staff in a new position is Morgan Timmerman, who will be serving as Faith Formation Associate. Morgan has already been working with Sacred Heart Parish in our School this last academic year in a part-time capacity as Middle School Religion Teacher. She will continue in this capacity, with the addition of new duties. As Faith Formation Associate, Morgan will be responsible for coordinating our Elementary Faith Formation Morgan Timmerman, Program, which is held on Wednesday evenings, and collaborating in shaping our Faith Formation Programs for elementary age students in both our Church and School. As Faith Formation Associate, Morgan will also collaborate with Matt Kruc, our Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministry, for both Youth Ministry as well as ministry to Young Adults, an area in need of greater focus. At the same time Matt will be taking a leadership role in guiding our Faith Formation Team. In the year ahead, Bunny Brouillard will also serve in a mentorship role for both Matt Kruc and Morgan Timmerman as we make these changes to our Faith Formation offerings. Please welcome Morgan Timmerman, a graduate in Catholic Studies and Theology from the University of Mary, Matt Kruc, Director



June Fahrmann, the sole abortionist/owner of this abortion facility, has expressed a concern about our effectiveness at her location. Having learned this, and knowing that the abortion numbers at this location are at a low, it would be good to join together in prayer, invoking God's intervention for the closing of this abortion facility.

We have a long history dealing with the Robbinsdale abortion mill and June Fahrmann. In 1987, the remains of thirteen aborted babies were found in the trash dumpster behind this building. In the early 1990's, Pro-Life action Ministries was sued in what became a prolonged court case resulting in an injunction that remains to this day. (Our prayer rally will be on *our* property adjacent to the abortion facility.) We encouraged and helped get a wonderful pregnancy help center, the Robbinsdale Women's Center, opened across the street. And many lives have been saved by our sidewalk counselors and this help center over the years, which has become of great concern in recent years for the abortionist/owner.

I hope to see you there on July 13!

Stand! is an opportunity to pray at area abortion facilities, hearing God's word, singing hymns, listening to testimonies and making a commitment to be present at these places of death on a scheduled and regular basis.


