Building Project Debt Update

Since the completion of our Building Project in December of 2012 we have carried debt. The overall project cost was approximately \$2.8 million. We had raised \$1.8 million in the Focus On Facilities Capital Campaign, meaning our debt from that project stood at \$1 million when our new facility opened. We have worked at paying off this debt since that time. Our follow-up Capital Campaign, Sacred Heart: Our Home. Our Mission. Our Future raised enough funds to complete our all day pre-school room, middle school science room, and our dedicated youth room, and funds necessary to retire our building project debt. I can report to you that as of 8/12/19 our building debt stands at \$0.

On behalf of the entire Sacred Heart Community I want to thank the many parishioners who supported both campaigns through their financial support. This generosity came through both pledges made, and from those who did not pledge yet still supported this great effort.

Thank you to the very generous parishioners who have contributed to reducing and subsequently eliminating our Ph. II Building Debt balance. If you still have a pledge yet to complete, we encourage you to fulfill that pledge as there are some smaller original Ph. II projects that were put on hold while we focused on the debt reduction portion of this project, that we may now be able to complete such as the rest of the wall sconces in the parish commons, and the donor recognition wall that was mentioned in our campaign literature.

One larger goal yet to be completed are the renovations to the school bathrooms and the dedicated Social Hall. We will be able to make some minor improvements in the near future, but are unable to do a complete renovation without a new source of funding such as a third capital campaign, a large bequest, or other large new donation that comes in as part of the Phase II campaign on which some who are on a five year fulfillment plan are still completing. Meeting these goals in the near future is not possible. Reiterating the good news, however, is the retirement of all building project related debt for which we must all rejoice and be glad.

On another matter I must also be the bearer of somber tidings, in that our Director of Liturgical Music and principal organist, Mr. Jeffrey Patry, received a job offer he couldn't refuse at First Lutheran Church in Columbia Heights. After more than eighteen years we must bid him adieu. We will have a reception for Jeffrey on Sunday September 8th following the 10am Mass. I hope you are able to join us to both thank Jeffrey for his years of dedication, his superb musical talents on both the Organ and Piano, not to mention his directing and conducting skills, and to say farewell.

In the meantime, we will seek an interim music director as we do a thorough search for a more permanent Director of Liturgical Music.

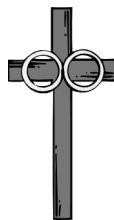
Dear Sacred Heart Parish,
