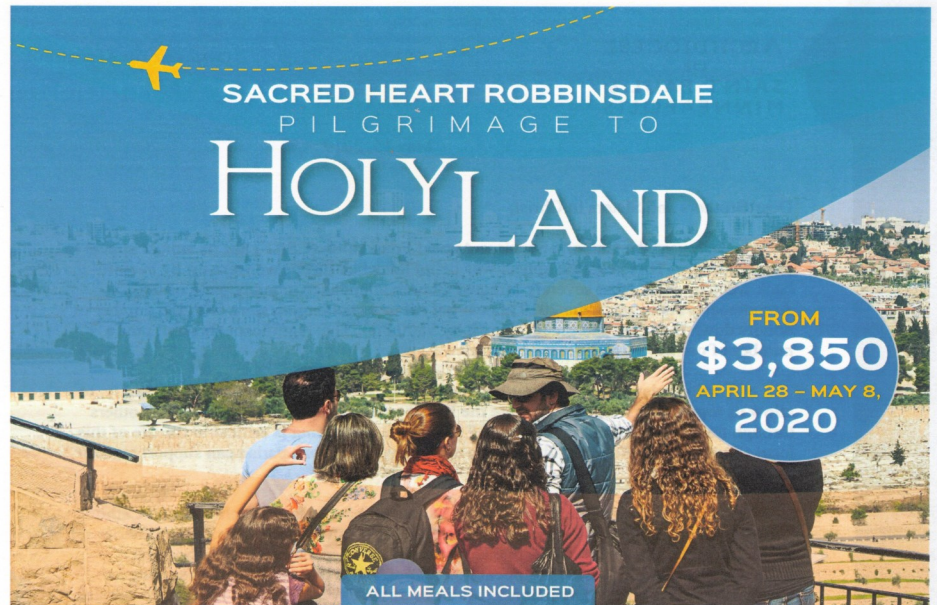

Lord, make our hearts pure as we prepare for the return of students to Sacred Heart Catholic School, and may you guide them to return with open hearts. What's New at Sacred Heart Catholic School?

What's New at Sacred Heart Catholic School?

- 1. CSCOE Groves Literacy Grant "Believe and Read"** - Sacred Heart Catholic School has been selected by Catholic Schools Center of Excellence as one of 18 Catholic elementary schools to participate in a literacy partnership with Groves Academy. The Groves Literacy Framework™ is a comprehensive, three-year program for reading and spelling instruction designed to prevent reading problems using evidence-based practices supported by scientific research. Weekly classroom coaching, monthly team meetings and other teacher supports are key to the Framework's success.
- 2. New religion curriculum, grades K-8**---*Spirit of Truth* covers the breadth of the entire *Catechism* in a rich and it is designed to help children internalize the Faith and apply it to their own lives. Students have the opportunity to reflect on how everything they are learning applies to their own experience.
- 3. New play area for our Pre-K Program**- Per licensing, our preschoolers need their own play area that is age appropriate for 3 and 4 year olds. A fenced in area will be located in the front of the convent along Hubbard Ave.
- 4. Top 20 Curriculum implemented in grades 6-8**---The last two years, teachers have had training implemented Top 20. The curriculum helps students learn skills in developing better relationships at home and school along with accepting consequences for the choices they make.
- 5. New math curriculum in grades 7 and 8**---Our new math curriculum will prepare our students for high school and provide practice of new concepts, along with review of concepts already learned.
- 6. Extra-Curriculars added: Karate and Lego Robotics**---Sterling Karate will be available Tuesday after school and Lego Robotics is back this year.
