Preparing for the coming Archdiocesan Synod

Last May during the Vigil of Pentecost Archbishop Hebda formally announced his intention that our Archdiocese will be embarking on a **synod**, our first since 1939 which will be held in May of 2021 over Pentecost Weekend. As he noted in a column in the Catholic Spirit appearing on June 6th, 2019 "A synod is a **formal representative assembly designed to help a bishop in his shepherding** of the local Church." We often think of the local Church as our neighborhood parish, but in fact a parish is a small part of the local Church aka diocesan Church.

When it comes to the organization of the Catholic Church I like to think of a Diocese or Archdiocese akin to state. Just as the state of Minnesota is divided into several counties in like manner every diocese is divided into several parishes. In the state of Louisiana, they even use the word parish instead of county. Every county in Minnesota has several cities and townships. Many parishes in a diocese will have a main church and sometimes will have satellite churches. In pioneer days these were called missions. In Africa they call them outstations. Our Parish of the Sacred Heart has but one Church building. Other parishes like Holy Cross in Northeast Minneapolis has a main church building and campus, Holy Cross, bearing the same name as the Parish itself, and several other satellite churches including St. Hedwig, St. Clement, and St. Anthony, at this time all existing as one Parish called Holy Cross.

Over the next two years Archbishop Hebda has a **pre-synod process which will encompass listening and prayer sessions** across the Archdiocese culminating in the Synod which seeks "to draw on the gifts that have been bestowed in such abundance on the faithful of this archdiocese to discern and establish clear pastoral priorities in a way that will both promote greater unity and lead the entire Archdiocese to a more vigorous proclamation of Jesus' good news."

There will be several ways in which this occurs. **First, he has asked every pastor to put together a Parish Ambassador Team of 12 members to promote the synod in each parish.** Their role is to make other parishioners aware of the synod preparation and listening sessions and to encourage fellow parishioners to take advantage of the Archbishop's invitation to listen to the faithful across the Archdiocese.

You might be asking yourself "what does the Archbishop mean by a listening session? Heeding the call of Pope Francis for the Church Universal to be a "listening Church" a listening session is a gathering of the Archbishop and faithful for a "sincere and respectful 'mutual listening' in which everyone has something to learn. Moreover, it is not just listening to one another but to the Holy Spirit, the 'Spirit of Truth' (Jn 14:17), to know what the Spirit is 'saying to the Churches' (Rev. 2:7)."

What is the goal of each **Prayer and Listening Event**? Participants will gather together to **pray, discuss, and give feedback on what is working well now in their parish and this Archdiocese, and what are the challenges and opportunities as we move forward together.** Everyone is invited to attend an event. All participants are encouraged to give written feedback that will be read and considered. **Archbishop Bernard Hebda is scheduled to attend all events** to pray and to participate in the listening process. While we might be tempted to think that it is Archbishop Hebda who will do all the listening with others doing all the talking, the goal is 'mutual listening' and even more importantly for all to strive to listen to the Holy Spirit, the 'Spirit of Truth.'

Look for the enclosed flyer for more information and dates for the upcoming prayer and listening events that will be held across the Archdiocese in preparation for the Synod.

Mark your calendar now so you can attend one of these prayer and listening events with Archbishop Hebda. And if you receive an email from me asking you to be a member of the Parish Ambassador Team whose role is to promote fellow parishioners to participate in the Synod, I pray that as you listen to the Holy Spirit you will be able to say yes to that call.
