
Eucharistic Adoration

Sacred Heart Catholic School -**Back on Campus for our 95th Year of Catholic Education** in Robbinsdale

As I type out this article, we are having our back to school day here at Sacred Heart Catholic School. Normally the event is much like an open house for existing students and parents to come by the campus and meet their new teachers for the years and make sure they are registered for all of the various programming options available to them such as band, hot lunch, bussing, etc. This year amid the Covid-19 pandemic our Back to School day is structured differently than usual with school families signing up for individual appointments with their teachers throughout the afternoon and evening.

Everything about this school year has been modified to keep our students, faculty, and staff as safe as possible while still allowing for in-person learning. At the same time, we do have about fourteen students who will be starting the school year at home through distance learning. What this means concretely is that these students will be participating while at home, while fellow students will be on campus. In order to make this happen teachers will have secure webcams in their classrooms. Whether at home or in the school building students will be taught by their teachers through lessons, question and answer time, and hands on instruction.

Social distancing will be among the methods used to keep everyone safe, as will a daily temperature check in the morning. Throughout the day instead of having students rotate to different classrooms for different subjects the teachers will be moving. These are just a couple of the provisions we will be utilizing to keep everyone safe.

I would ask that you keep Sacred Heart Catholic School in your prayers. Whether it is for just part of the year or the whole year we are ready to meet the challenge of this pandemic head on to continue our mission of Catholic education.
