

# **A Game of Crosses**

Some may have noticed that the Crucifix visible in the Sacred Heart Chapel looking to the Sanctuary has been removed. An image of that crucifix is below. This particular crucifix has been in several different locations through the years. Following the installation of the Organ in 1989, but before the installation of the Rose Window in the middle 1990's this cross was suspended from the ceiling of the Church roughly hanging where the Rose Window in the sanctuary now stands. Following the installation of the Rose window it was moved to the right side of the Sanctuary in front of the old organ veneer panels. In 2006, when the new Oak Reredos was installed, it was moved again. In the image you can see that it is somewhat oversized for that space.

This crucifix is moving again to a place of greater prominence on our campus where it will be the central focal point. Since the 2012 building project I have wanted to have a crucifix in the Parish Commons. This large crucifix will find its new place between the stain glass windows of the western wall of the Parish Commons. The Mankato stone surrounding the windows will serve as a backdrop for this beautifully carved large crucifix. I believe it will fit perfectly in this new location, and some will think it was purchased for this placement.

The large crucifix is not the only cross being moved, and the space between the arches in the passage leading to the sacristy between the Sacred Heart Chapel and the sanctuary will not be empty for long. A smaller wood carved crucifix that used to hang in the Activities Building Lobby leading into the gymnasium will takes its place. This crucifix became somewhat lost when a marble statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus from the Old St. Ambrose Church was placed underneath it. Here are some images of how the smaller crucifix will look in its new location. I hope you agree with me that it too looks like it was made for this location in our church.
