

#### Mass and Liturgy Changes

Recently, our Business Administrator, Mary Daugherty, used a great analogy for our liturgical life *vis-à-vis* the pandemic and getting back to normal which I would like to quote:

"Coming out of the pandemic is not like turning the light switch back on."

I think there is great wisdom in that statement. When it concerns Mass and worship, it is more akin to turning several different dials, and then gradually dialing them back to the normative position. Our ability is in steps and stages, and thus will take some time. Yet, as more and more of everyday life is normalized coming out of the pandemic aspects of our worship that were directly affected will be less so.

With this weekend most of the ropes that blocked certain pews for social distancing will be removed. It had been our plan to remove them all this coming weekend, however, after a conversation with the Parish Pastoral Council at our last meeting it was determined that we should still have some parts of the Church where those with concerns regarding Covid-19 can make use of pews that have built-in social distancing that the ropes provide. For the time being I will continue the Saturday 5:30pm parking lot Mass. The Archdiocese has mentioned July 1<sup>st</sup> as another date when changes to the protocols will occur. As that date draws near, we will again evaluate when to end the parking lot Mass. Another example of a change will be the resumption of two lines for Holy Communion with this weekend as opposed to just one line. The congregation will process toward the Altar.

During the Summer Months after the conclusion of the School Year our Mass and Liturgy schedule will be changing slightly.

The Monday Morning Word and Communion Service at 8:00 AM will resume on June 7<sup>th</sup>. This service will be followed by Morning Prayer (Lauds) at the Choir Stalls

The biggest change to the schedule will come on Tuesdays. Beginning June 8<sup>th</sup>, the Tuesday 8:00 AM Morning Mass will switch to a Tuesday evening Mass at 6:30 PM. Confessions will be heard preceding this Mass from 5:30 PM to 6:15 PM. Evening Prayer (Vespers) will immediately precede the Mass at 6:15pm at the Choir Stalls. We anticipate that the Tuesday daily Mass will return to 8:00 AM on Tuesday, September 7<sup>th</sup> when School is in session.

Morning Prayer will again follow Morning Mass on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday at the Choir Stalls.

During the Summer months we will also have a morning Mass on the First Saturday of each month at 8:00AM. Following this Mass morning prayer will be held at the Choir Stalls. Confessions will be heard in the Chapel from 9:00-9:30 AM on the First Saturday of each month going forward. Confession will not precede the first Saturday Mass during the summer months.

The Mass of Anticipation on Saturday Evening in Church will remain at 4:00PM. The Parking Lot Mass continues at 5:30PM for the time being. When the parking lot Mass does end, the Saturday evening Mass of Anticipation, though, will remain at 4:00PM. There is no change to the Sunday schedule.

As Archdiocesan Protocols change during the summer months, we will provide updates. Little by little the dials are being set back to normative position.


