Mass Schedule

With the resumption of the school year, we have two changes to our liturgical schedule. The first change regards Tuesday. **Mass will return to 8:00 AM beginning Tuesday, September 7th and will remain at that time until Memorial Day.** Lauds (morning prayer) follows this Mass at the choir stalls. The second change regards Saturday. During the summer months we only had morning Mass on First Saturdays. **With the resumption of school year, we will have morning Mass every Saturday at 8:00 AM.** Lauds (morning prayer) follows this Mass at the choir stalls. On the First Saturday of each month following morning prayer confessions will be heard in the Sacred Heart Chapel/Cry Room from 9:00 – 9:30 AM.

The Mass of Anticipation on Saturday Evening in Church will remain at 4:00PM. The Parking Lot Mass continues at 5:30PM for the time being. **There will not be a parking lot Mass on Saturday, September 18th.** I am still discerning if the parking lot Mass will continue into autumn/fall. When the parking lot Mass does end, the Saturday evening Mass of Anticipation will remain at 4:00PM. There is no change to the Sunday schedule.

Raising the Roof

This past week we replaced three flat roofs on the Church above the Narthex located on 41st Ave N. The replacement roofs are the traditional built-up roof system. With these three sections completed the only flat roof section needing replacement is above the sacristy. The roof above the Sacred Heart Chapel was replaced in 2012 concurrent with the addition. The roof above the Hubbard vestibule was replaced in 2019. Central Roofing accomplished this project.

Outdoor Classroom

Thanks to the generosity of an anonymous donor an outdoor classroom space has been developed on Hubbard Ave. N in front of the school. A special thank you to Dave Detloff for taking the time to assemble the benches. The classroom project was designed and installed by PA Lawn Service. In addition to this classroom, PA Lawn service also redid the landscaping on Hubbard Ave. N for both the Church and the School. The owner of PA Lawn Service, Patrick, lives here in Robbinsdale on Hubbard Ave. N. Sacred Heart has been very satisfied with the service PA provides and the results are doing much to improve our curb appeal.

Another project on the horizon is a parish office rehab with new carpet, repainting of the office, and new work cubicles on the way. Your prayers for a successful completion of all these projects is very much appreciated. Thank you also to Steve & Mary Bromander, Tom Stanoch, Dave Detloff and Peter Krych who have helped us with various indoor and outdoor campus projects this summer.

We are replacing some additional flat roofs on the church. Some of our church entrances may be inaccessible. We apologize for any inconvenience.

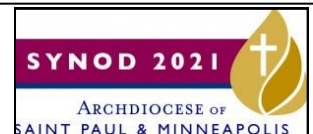
Synod Small Groups**What to Expect when you participate in Synod small groups this Fall**

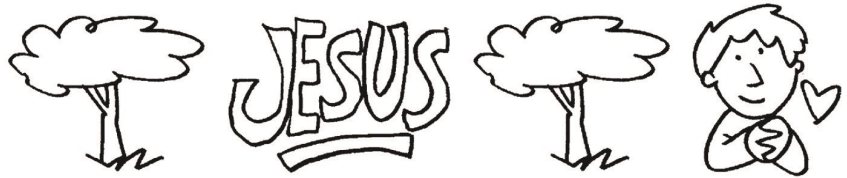
