The Cenacle

In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium, the children work with a raised surface model of the city of Jerusalem. Jerusalem is one of the most important cities in the land of Israel because Jesus lived the greatest moments of his earthly life there. In the City of Jerusalem, we find the Cenacle or the Upper Room was where Jesus celebrated the Last Supper and said those new and special words "This is my Body...", "This is my Blood..." The word cenacle means "dining room."
