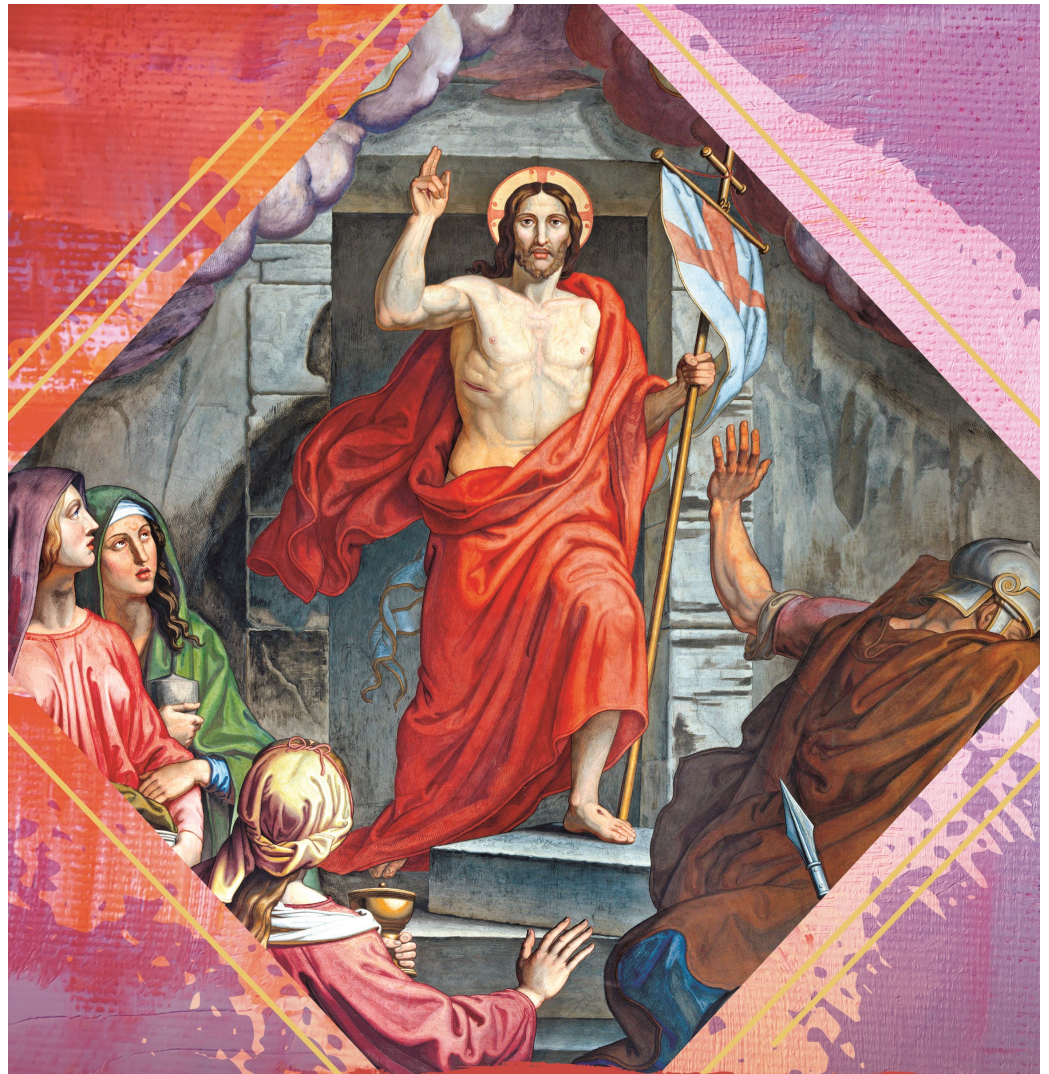



### Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

After a long absence the alleluia returns to us. Like the word 'amen', 'alleluia' is also a Hebrew word that we continue to use in the liturgy. Alleluia means "praise YHWH". Ancient words in ancient languages bear witness to the reality that Christian faith has been transmitted to us throughout 2000 years. Our belief in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ is based upon the testimony of eye-witnesses who lived at the time of Jesus! The apostles and disciples in Jesus' time are the ones who discovered the empty tomb. They are the ones who give testimony that the Lord appeared to them over 40 days. He was no ghost, he had a body, but it was changed. It was glorious. We have faith in their testimony and we rejoice because the Resurrection of Christ is a promise of our future inheritance. As St. Paul writes "Death, where is your victory? Death where is your sting?" If there was no Resurrection death would be final. We are meant to have a body, and the resurrected body of Jesus gives our souls hope beyond the grave. Even if our loved ones who have died enjoy the vision of God in heaven they still yearn to have a resurrected and glorified body. There is still something they await. We have confidence in the testimony of the apostles. At the foot of the cross all but one abandoned Jesus, but after experiencing his Resurrection they went to the ends of the earth to proclaim the good news, the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Except for one they died to transmit this hope to us. Through the centuries the saints and martyrs have done likewise. This Easter we respond with faith and worship Jesus as the Son of God. Through the Resurrection of Jesus our hope for an eternity of happiness with our God our Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit breaks forth. May it resonate each and every day as we sing Alleluia!

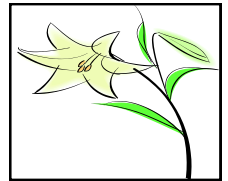

### The Mount of Olives

In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium, the children work with a raised surface to model the city of Jerusalem. Jerusalem is one of the most important cities in the land of Israel because Jesus lived the greatest moments of his earthly life there. After the Last Supper with his friends, Jesus went to this garden, one of his favorite places, a quiet place where he liked to pray. The Garden or Mount of Olives was located just outside the city walls. It was there that Jesus was arrested and taken back into the city of Jerusalem. In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium, the children work with a raised surface model of the city of Jerusalem.

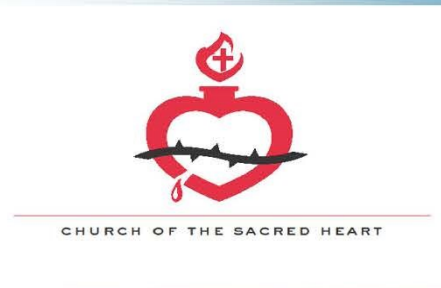
