



### **Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture**

My dad was adopted as a baby. It's a big part of my family's story. His birth mother placed him in a Catholic orphanage not long after birth. A young couple longing for a baby strolled among the bassinets. My father, then only a few months old, looked at the husband and smiled. The man said, "That's my son." They took him home and the family grew. This moment of adoption was a wonderful truth they celebrated even when my dad was a young boy. They told him, "You're even more special than the other children, because we chose you to be our son." My dad's eyes well up with tears of gratitude whenever he tells the story, even eighty-three years later.

What is your story? Do we think or act like unwanted orphans? Who do we believe ourselves to be? As we continue to ponder Jesus' resurrection, we hear him say to us this Sunday, "I will not leave you orphans." God doesn't leave us alone like spiritual orphans. The power that raised Jesus from the dead is the Holy Spirit, who is also called the Spirit of Adoption. He chooses us to be His children, to share God's life forever. He gives us a future filled with hope. We are not orphans anymore! This Easter, that's the story we should share with others. It's the true story we are living right now.


#### **Adopt A Garden Week This Summer**

#### The Paschal Candle in the Liturgy of Light

"What appears to affect the children most deeply is their participation in the annual celebration of the Liturgy of Light, together with all the groups of children and adults in the atrium. It is during this celebration, in the richness and solemnity of its liturgical context, that the children come to know the Paschal Candle, which occupies a very important place in other presentations. Young children always live this celebration with moments of striking silence and great enjoyment." – Sofia Cavalletti, *The Development of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: Inside the Atria in Rome*, p.17

#### **Spiritual Adoption**

MONTH THREE-Your baby is quite active in the womb now - although her mother won't feel her for another couple of months. If her mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow and move her tongue. She can make a tight fist if you touch her palm. She is breathing amniotic fluid which continues until birth, although

she obtains the oxygen her body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce. **Say the following daily prayer for a period of nine months.** 

"Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of [baby's name] the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion."


