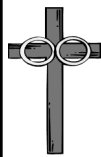



The Liturgy of Light

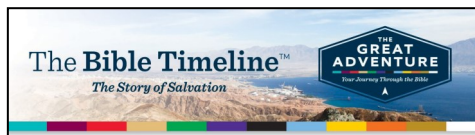

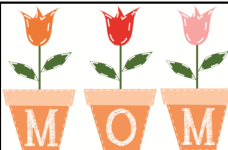
