

# Pastor's Page Fr. Bryan J.B. Pedersen

#### **Twenty Years of Priesthood**

I am writing to you today, May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 from a cottage at Grand View Lodge on Gull Lake in Nisswa, using my index finger and the Office 365 app to compose this brief message. That I am here is due to a generous anonymous benefactor in the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis who has, for the second time, sponsored a Homiletics Conference for Priests of the Archdiocese. Homiletics is the art of preaching. When I found out there was still space for the Conference in early April I quickly signed up to come.

Our presenters are Fr. Aquinas Guilbeau, O.P., a Dominican, and Fr. Daniel Scheidt of the Diocese of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and pastor of St. Vincent de Paul, also in Fort Wayne. In the three sessions thus far the presenters have not spoken about preaching techniques, but rather have focused on apostolic living, that is, in order "to proclaim the Gospel wor-thily and well" preaching must first flow from that relationship had with the Living Word of God, Jesus Christ.

Fr. Aquinas shared with us how a Dominican Priory, the place where Dominicans live, pray, eat, sleep, and have their community life is ordered to Sacred Preaching and the mission of the Order of Preachers. Building on this, Fr. Scheidt has suggested that the daily and weekly horarium, or schedule of life for the priest and how he lives, and even the rectory where he resides, just like a Dominican Priory, should likewise be structured in such a way as to reinforce apostolic living – that is living with, for, and entirely for Christ – as the true roots of good preaching.

It has been a blessing thus far to be both with Archbishop Hebda and brother priests, especially on my 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Priestly Ordination. It was also very fitting to concelebrate Mass with Archbishop Bernard Hebda, twenty years to the day I was ordained by Archbishop Harry Flynn, and concelebrated Mass with him and my brother priests for the first time at the Cathedral of St. Paul!

## Saint Biography

#### St. Norbert-Feast Day June 6th

Born to nobility, St. Norbert of Xanten, was ordained as a subdeacon and served in the court of Henry V, Emperor of Germany, however, at court it was easy to be distracted by wealth, power and luxury and he lived a worldly and corrupt life there. By the grace of God while traveling in a storm he was nearly struck by lightning and almost killed. This experience changed St. Norbert and he became penitent, left his court post, and


after a period of discernment in a monastery, felt called to be a priest.

Norbert became an itinerant preacher, preaching against worldly attitudes but at the Pope's request finally settled in northern France and founded the Norbertine order established according to the rule of St. Augustine. The order grew rapidly and soon founded women's branch. Norbert traveled and preached across Germany where he also founded a lay branch of the Norbertines. In Belgium he preached against heresies which denied the Blessed Sacrament.

Eventually he was made Archbishop of Magdeburg, Germany, and later he traveled to Rome in support of Pope Innocent II, against the antipope. Afterward he returned to Germany to court of Emperor Lothar as advisor, at end of life, in failing health, St. Norbert was carried back to Magdeburg where he died.
