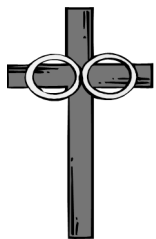
Sacred Heart Parish is forming a Prayer Group, meeting on the First Saturday of the Month.

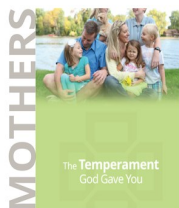

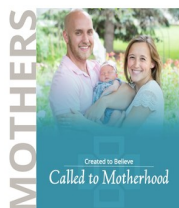
