Hello!

My name is Katie Kruc and as the new youth minister here at Sacred Heart, I'd like to take a little time to introduce myself. This is perhaps an unpopular opinion, but I love how cold Minnesota winters are. I've noticed a trend: it gets so cold that even your memories freeze. The colder it is, the more distinct the memory. There was one day, about a year and a half ago where the weather was just that. Bitter. And I remember the events of it very clearly. I was walking out of my interview with NET Ministries, and I was considering how I would respond if they accepted me for a spot as a missionary. I was going to (and did) graduate from the University of Minnesota with a degree in Human Physiology. Though I had volunteered with Sacred Heart's confirmation program and Extreme Faith Camp over the past few years in addition to starting up a women's small group ministry at the Newman Center, I hadn't thought that I would go into full time ministry. In that moment, I remember knowing two things. Number one: I was *extremely* cold. Number two: I would probably say yes to serving with NET. And I would go for the same reason that I chose to study medicine in college: a desire to help make people whole and to bring healing where it is needed. And who is better at healing than Christ? And with these two thoughts frozen in place, I would go onto to serve as a team lead for a discipleship team at St. Simon the Apostle Catholic Church and School down in Indianapolis. With that experience, my course was changed, and I am thoroughly looking forward to serving Sacred Heart with everything that I've learned and experienced throughout my time in ministry. And whether you agree with my thoughts on the weather or not, feel free to stop me if you see me. I'd love to get to know you.

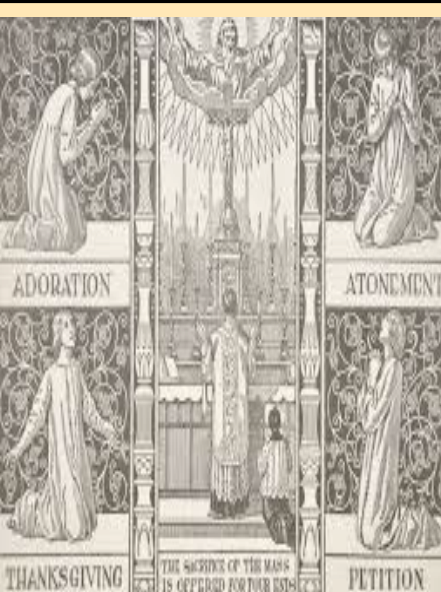

PRE-BAPTISM CLASSES

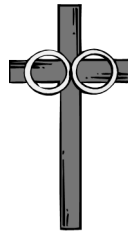
