Sustaining Our Cathedral and Basilica

\$30M of the Lord, Renew Your Church campaign will be used for essential renovations, deferred maintenance, and upgrades at both churches to ensure their preservation for the glory of God and the sustenance of His people. 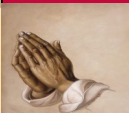

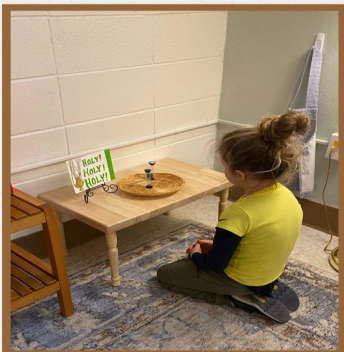

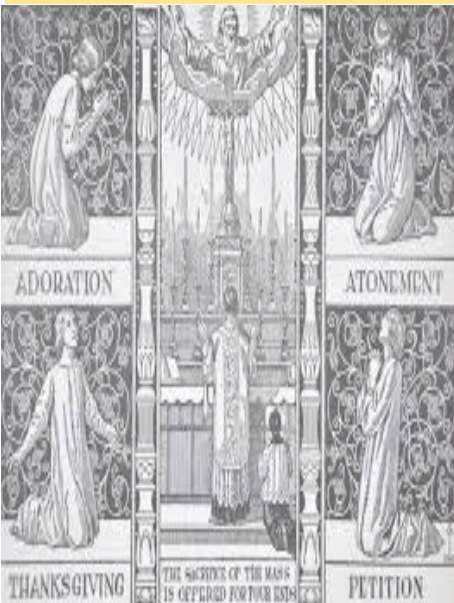
