\$25M of the Lord, Renew Your Church campaign will be used to fully fund the priest pension plan, support clergy wellness and training, assist seminarians with educational opportunities, and more. 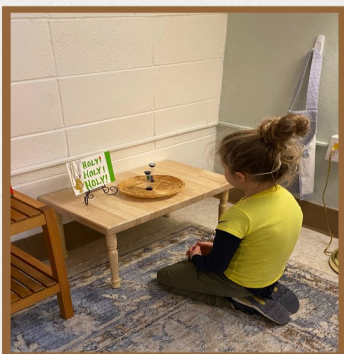

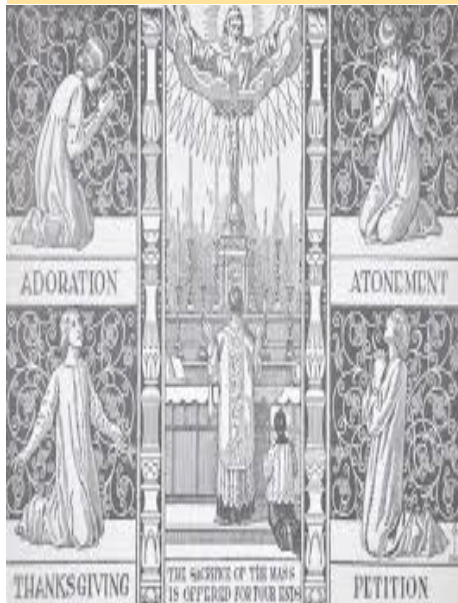

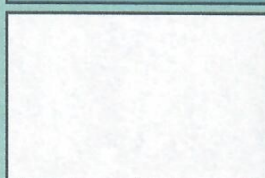
