CAMPAIGN UPDATE

As of April 22, 2025

Corporal Works of Mercy

Over \$12M of the Lord, Renew Your Church campaign will be used to establish an endowment for responding to requests for assistance, allowing us to serve neighbors in need within our diverse communities. Pope Francis has often reminded us that the Church is a field hospital for those in need. Our hope is to be the hands and face of Christ among those with the least and provide a meaningful gesture of support when it is needed most.

As our parish draws closer to our goal, the benefits will grow significantly! Once we surpass our goal, the parish will receive 80% of the funds raised beyond \$910,000. If we achieve between 151% and 199% of our goal, the parish share will increase to an impressive 90%. And if we reach twice our target, the parish will receive 100% of the funds raised beyond 200% of our goal. This is an incredible opportunity for us to make a lasting impact on our community and our parish!

Thanks to the generous hearts of our Parish Community, Sacred Heart has raised \$836,400 out of our \$910,000 goal. We are 92% of the way there! Our parishioners continue to give generously! We are deeply grateful for those who have already contributed to our goal. 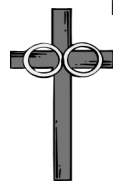
