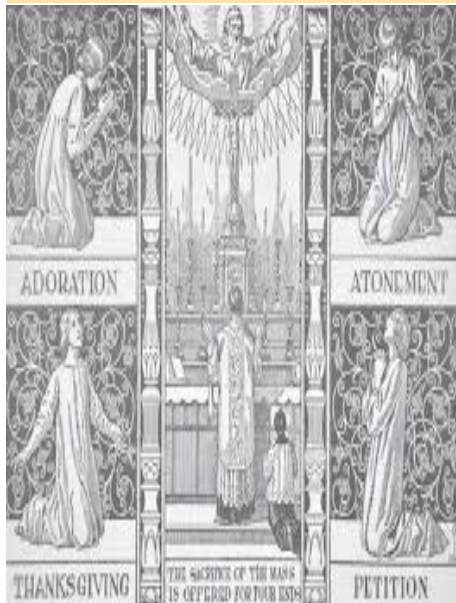

Did you learn this rhyme in childhood? St. Anthony of Padua is more than the patron saint for lost items. By his life, he shows a special interest in lost souls. St. Anthony was born to noble parents, but he preferred a simple life of faith to the riches of his childhood. He joined the Franciscan order in 1220. He quickly became known for his eloquence in preaching. He had a way of reaching all sorts, from nobles to clergy to those who had fallen away from the Catholic faith. In addition to preaching, St. Anthony organized supplies for the poor and negotiated release for prisoners of war between Italian city-states. However you or your loved ones feel lost this week, pray for St. Anthony's intercession!

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Over the next several weeks, I will be writing a series about the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and introducing you to what we do in the atrium with our 3-6-year-old children.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is the Montessori method of religious education. It seeks to create a sacred, hands-on space for children, in which they can ponder the most essential mysteries of the faith as revealed in Scripture and the Liturgy.

The atrium is a place of prayer in which work and study spontaneously become meditation, contemplation, and prayer.

- A spirit of prayer is nurtured throughout the atrium:
 - The environment is essential, simple, ordered, and beautiful.
 - Cultivation of silence.
 - Proclamation of the Good News.
 - Giving opportunities to respond through personal work.
 - Communal prayer time and celebrations.
